



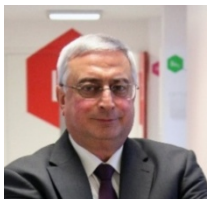

GEORGES HADZIOANNOU



Georges Hadziioannou was born in 1953 in Kavala in Greece, received the titles of Bachelor in Chemistry from the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki in 1975 and of Docteur és Sciences Physiques from the University Louis Pasteur & Research Center on Macromolecules (CNRS) of Strasbourg in 1980.

Since 2009 he is Full Professor of Chemistry at University of Bordeaux (France) and Holder of the Industrial Chair of Arkema / ANR: HOMERIC "Hierarchical Assembled Organic Materials for ElectRonICs". He is the head of the "Polymer Electronic Materials & Devices" team at the Laboratoire de Chimie des Polymères Organiques (LCPO). Since 2008 he is a member of the Institut Universitaire de France (IUF) in the Chair of Physical Polymer Chemistry. He is also Director of ELORPrintTec EquipEx and Scientific Director of AMADEus LabEx.

He has been professor at the University of Groningen (The Netherlands), and at the Louis-Pasteur University of Strasbourg, and invited professor at various universities in France, Greece, Sweden, Belgium and USA.

He has published more than 395 research papers (h-index: 64) and has written books on organic electronics. He has given 177 invited lectures at scientific conferences. He has 45 patents, and has supervised 56 PhD students and more than 70 postdoctoral researchers and invited professors.

He was elected a fellow of the American Physical Society, received the Humboldt Research Award in Germany and the Süe Award from the French Chemical Society. He is a member of the Scientific Council of the French chemical company ARKEMA, the Academia Europaea and the Institut Universitaire de France. He has been honored with the "La Recherche" Chemistry Award. In 2016 he was elected Foreign Member of the US National Academy of Engineering.
